

# Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting (IQR) and Medicare Promoting Interoperability Programs



## Calendar Year (CY) 2025 Electronic Clinical Quality Measure (eCQM) Submission Overview

<b>Program Requirements</b>	<p>Submit data for three eCQMs selected by CMS and three self-selected eCQMs for all four quarters of CY 2025. The eCQMs must be the same eCQMs across quarters in the reporting year. Each quarter must contain the same six eCQMs.</p> <p><b>3 CMS-Selected eCQMs</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Safe Use of Opioids-Concurrent Prescribing</li> <li>2. Cesarean Birth (Perinatal Care [PC]-02)</li> <li>3. Severe Obstetric Complications (PC-07)</li> </ol> <p><b>3 Self-Selected eCQMs</b></p> <p>Three self-selected eCQMs must come from the <a href="#">CY 2025 Available eCQMs Table</a>.</p>	<b>Dual Program Acceptance</b>	<p>Hospitals that successfully submit eCQM data via the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) System will meet the eCQM reporting requirement for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hospital IQR Program*</li> <li>• Medicare Promoting Interoperability Program for eligible hospitals and critical access hospitals (CAHs)**</li> </ul>
<b>Submission Deadline</b>	<p><b>Monday, March 2, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time</b></p>	<b>System Availability</b>	<p>The HQR System will be open for Test and Production file submissions in Fall 2025.</p>
<b>Technical Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use the <a href="#">Assistant Secretary for Technology Policy/Office of the National Coordinator (ONC) Health Information Technology certification criteria</a> to meet the certified electronic health record technology requirement.</li> <li>• Use eCQM specifications published in the 2024 eCQM annual update for CY 2025 reporting and applicable addenda, available on the <a href="#">Eligible Hospital/Critical Access Hospital eCQMs page of the eCQI Resource Center</a>.</li> <li>• Use the 2025 CMS Implementation Guide for Quality Reporting Document Architecture (QRDA) Category I, Schematron, and sample QRDA Category I files on the <a href="#">QRDA page of the eCQI Resource Center</a>.</li> </ul>	<b>Successful Submission</b>	<p>Data must be submitted through the <i>HQR Secure Portal</i> as any combination of these:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• QRDA Category I files with patients meeting the initial patient population of the applicable measure(s)</li> <li>• Zero denominator declarations</li> <li>• Case threshold exemptions</li> </ul>
<b>Who Can Submit Data</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hospitals with a Health Care Quality Information Systems Access Roles and Profile (HARP) account can submit.</li> <li>• Electronic health record vendors can create a HARP account to submit data on the hospital's behalf.</li> <li>• Hospitals can log in to the <a href="#">HQR Secure Portal</a> and the Vendor Management System to assign, modify, and remove vendor access from one page. Users receive instant confirmation of changes.</li> </ul>	<b>File Validation Tool</b>	<p>Via the HQR System, hospitals and their vendors can validate QRDA Category I test and production file structure and contents and generate CSV files for feedback to correct QRDA Category I files prior to production re-submissions.</p>
