Who Can Submit Data	 Hospitals with a Health Care Quality Information Systems Access Roles and Profile (HARP) account can submit. Electronic health record vendors can create a HARP account to submit data on the hospital's behalf. Hospitals can log in to the <u>HQR Secure</u> <u>Portal</u> and the Vendor Management System to assign, modify, and remove vendor access from one page. Users receive instant confirmation of changes.
