# Publication of the Final Rule

The fiscal year (FY) 2024 Inpatient Prospective Payment System/ Long-Term Care Hospital Prospective Payment System <u>final rule</u> (pages 564–593) finalized the following changes:

- Modified the COVID-19 Vaccination Among Healthcare Personnel (HCP) measure (pages 498–505)
- Adopted three health equity measures: Facility Commitment to Health Equity, Screening for Social Drivers of Health, and Screen Positive Rate for Social Drivers of Health
- Adopted the Documentation of Goals of Care Discussions Among Cancer Patients measure
- Finalized public display of the Surgical Treatment Complications for Localized Prostate Cancer measure
- Modified the data submission and reporting requirements for the Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (HCAHPS) Survey measure

  - End of Life (EOL) measures (PCH-32, PCH-33, PCH-34, and PCH-35)
- Fall 2024
  - Cancer Readmissions measure (PCH-36)

# What's Next? Public Reporting

- HCAHPS Survey data will continue to be publicly refreshed quarterly.
- HAI measures will continue to be publicly refreshed as follows:
  - Quarterly: CAUTI, CLABSI, SSI, MRSA, CDI, and COVID-19 HCP
  - Annually: Influenza HCP
- Beginning with the January 2024 PDC release, PCH-15 data files will be removed.
  - This measure data was refreshed for the last time in January 2023.

# What's Next? Public Reporting

- FY 2025 EOL and Prostate Cancer measure claims data are anticipated to be publicly reported for the first time in July 2024.
  - EOL data collection period: July 1, 2022–June 30, 2023
  - Prostate Cancer data collection period: July 1, 2021–June 30, 2022
  - Measure reports will be available in Spring 2024.
- Modified version of the COVID-19 HCP measure data are anticipated to be publicly reported in October 2024.


