The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Inpatient & Outpatient Healthcare Quality System Development and Program Support Contractor are pleased to notify Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Reporting (IPFQR) Program participants that the *Specifications Manual for National Inpatient Psychiatric Facility Quality Measures* (IPF Specifications Manual), version 1.3, effective January 1, 2025, is available for download. The IPF Specifications Manual references the XML file layouts for clinical measure and non-measure data, which are published as separate Excel spreadsheets.

Key updates to version 1.3 include:

- Updated the Introduction to the Data Dictionary to provide a definition and clarification for medical records.
- Added the "unable to determine from medical record documentation" to the "No" allowable values to the applicable data elements to align with the Missing Data Policy.
- Updated the General Data Elements tables for the Screening for Metabolic Disorders and Transition Record measures to align with the current data elements for these measures.
- Updated the Missing Data Policy to include the Non-Measure Data elements where the "unable to determine" value is not applicable.
- Added CMS sampling approaches to the Population & Sampling section.
- Added a new section for Non-Measure Data specifications.
- Updated the Data Transmission section to align with current transmission processes.
